

CCS reductions can apply to those who are eligible and who have registered with Centrelink.

Please return all forms to OSHC, via email or the school Office with a payment of <u>HALF</u> the fees by 1st December 2021. Payments can be made through QKR APP.

To secure your booking, please fill out and return the form promptly.

Please be aware that places are capped at 35 children (30 on excursion days).

An email will be sent for confirmation of booking.

Your child/ren may be placed onto a waitlist if places are not available. Sessions must have 15 children booked to go ahead in order to cover staff costs. PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF OUR BOOKING CONDITIONS AND CANCELLATION POLICY.

OSHC/ Vacation Care Booking Conditions

According to the Commonwealth Priority of Access Guidelines, priority of booking is given to children of those parents who are working full/part time or studying during the vacation period, over those needing recreational care or parents with outstanding accounts. Priority is given to the children of St. John Bosco School before others.

It is a condition of enrolment that parents/guardians have an understanding of the information and expectations laid out in the OSHC Handbook, and that each child's enrolment form is up to date.

A 50% payment of fees must be paid before your child/ren's enrolment can be confirmed. Bookings will only be accepted when the 50% payment is made and any outstanding BSC/ASC/Vacation Care fees are finalised. If a child cannot attend due to illness, a Doctor's certificate may be required in order to avoid paying the fee for the missed day. Please promptly advise the OSHC staff about absence due to illness.

Any bookings on Vacation care that are **cancelled after 9am the day prior or 'no-show'** will be charged a **cancellation fee that is equal to the full day's fee** if the position cannot be filled off the waiting list. Please cancel the day prior by 9am or on drop off to avoid paying fees

Please note a condition for booking your child to attend OSHC on an advertised excursion day, means your child will attend the excursion, NO CHILD will be left at school.

If your child/ren has been placed on the waiting list, then it is the parents/ responsibility to telephone and check for availability with the OSHC Director. You will be advised if your child has been approved or will need to be placed onto the waitlist for a requested booking when your booking form is received. Please do not assume that your child has been accepted onto the booking list or moved from the waiting list. An OSHC Educator will contact you to approve your bookings and also if any changes are made to your child's waitlist status.

If a child's enrolment form or the returned Vacation Care booking form indicates that medication is required for a child, it is the parent's responsibility to ensure that medication is handed over to OSHC Educators upon drop off on the child's first day of attendance. This also includes providing OSHC with any emergency medical plans (ie. Asthma, Anaphylaxis, Allergies) and written instructions on dosage. All medication is to be kept in a secure location by the OSHC Educators. It should be noted that OSHC Staff are not responsible for sourcing or supplying medication for any child.

The program may change to suit circumstances. All excursions are subject to last minute changes or cancellations due to weather conditions, booking issues or attendance numbers.

All children must be signed in and out by a parent. A staff member must be notified of a child's arrival to and departure from the service.

The supervision of children is strictly limited to the hours advised (a late fee of \$1 a minute applies after 6:00pm). This cost is implemented to cover staff wages.

Any media brought from home must be rated G. This includes movies, games and any media on devices. Please be aware that some PG-rated media from OSHC's existing collection of DVD movies and Wii games may be accessed during the course of the session, under the supervision of an OSHC Educator. Devices brought from home must be kept behind Educator's desk and usage time is restricted. No apps or features with camera or recording functions may be accessed, and we ask that no functions which require data or an internet connection are used. If contact needs to be made between a parent or child, the OSHC phone and email are the appropriate communication methods.

Any child exhibiting unsafe, harmful or inappropriate behaviour may be excluded from the service and a parent called to pick him/her up from OSHC. In the event of any serious misbehaviour while on an excursion, a parent will be contacted and will be expected to collect their child or make necessary arrangements for a trusted adult to do so.

For WHS reasons and in accordance with St John Bosco School's Sun Smart Policy, children attending Vacation Care must wear closed in shoes (no slipons, thongs etc) and they must be worn at all times. They must have a hat every day and during the Christmas Vacation, sleeveless clothing is not acceptable. Sunscreen should also be applied before attendance and regularly throughout the day.

Note any special clothes or footwear needed for scheduled OSHC activities.

Parents of children who become unwell will be contacted and asked to collect their child. A child in need of urgent medical attention will be taken to hospital by ambulance. Parents are responsible for all medical, ambulance or related costs incurred. Continued attempts to inform the parent or emergency contact will be undertaken in such circumstances until contact is made.

In the event of an accident or illness involving a child, where contact with parent/caregivers is unsuccessful despite continued attempts, the staff member in charge is authorised to consent (on behalf of the parent/caregivers) to any emergency/ critical medical or surgical treatment if a registered medical practitioner considers it urgent and necessary. The doctor or medical specialist listed on a child's enrolment form may be contacted on behalf of a parent in an emergency to arrange consultation, and any necessary or relevant details may also be passed on to medical personnel.

DEVICE USAGE CONDITIONS AGREEMENT

To access the privilege of device usage while at OSHC, parent and child <u>must</u> agree to the following conditions:

- You may only use your device for 1 hour or less per day.
- Devices must be left behind the OSHC Educator's desk, and only accessed after being given permission from an OSHC Educator.
- Devices may only be used in the designated area (green carpet mat and couches next to it).
- Do not allow others to use your device. You may not use someone else's device.
- You may not use the camera app or any similar apps that take photos or record videos.
- You may not use any features of your device to call/message/facetime others while at OSHC. If you need to contact someone, or someone needs to contact you, the OSHC phone can be used.
- You may not use YouTube/streaming apps or features requiring a data/internet connection.
- Games/apps being used must be appropriate for school and rated G or PG.

Children not following the conditions will NOT be able to access their device for the remainder of the day. Parents will be informed on pickup of the inappropriate behaviour.
