Week 1

Monday 30 September

In Day - Hama Bead Day

\$55 + No additional charges.

Children will participate in a Hama Bead, fun-filled day creating their favourite designs, whether a key chain or a present for their friends and family. Children can make their own school bag or pencil case key rings, as well as a range of other creations.

Tuesday 1 October

Excursion - National Railway Museum

\$55 + Additional charge of \$25 P.P

The bus departs at 9.30 am for a trip to the National Railways Museum in Port Adelaide. Children will explore the mechanical and social history of the railways.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Please return all forms to OSHC via the QKR App or the School Office.

Upon request a Payment of \$30 per day by Thursday the 26th of September is required to secure bookings.

Please be aware that places are capped at 45 children (40 on excursion days).

An email will be sent confirming your booking.

As places are limited, your child/ren may be waitlisted.

In order to cover our costs, sessions must have a minimum of 20 children booked.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF OUR BOOKING CONDITIONS AND CANCELLATION POLICY

According to the Commonwealth Priority of Access Guidelines, priority of booking is given to children of those parents who are working full/part time or studying during the vacation period, over those needing recreational care or parents with outstanding accounts. Priority is given to children of St. John Bosco School over others.

It is a condition of enrolment that parents/guardians have an understanding of the information and expectations laid out in the OSHC Handbook, and that each child's enrolment form is up to date.

The cost per day is \$55.00 + additional charges for Incursions and Excursions. CCS reductions may apply to those who are eligible and have registered with Centrelink (this applies only to the standard fee of \$55.00 and not additional charges). Bookings can be made through the Director via Email. Please use the QKR App for deposit payments and consent forms. Upon request a \$30.00 deposit per day is required to secure bookings for all Incursions and Excursions. Any outstanding BSC/ASC/Vacation Care fees must be finalised before booking Vacation Care.

If a child cannot attend due to illness, a Doctor's certificate may be required in order to avoid paying the fee for a missed day. Please promptly advise OSHC staff of absence due to illness.

Cancellations received after 9am the day prior or 'no-shows' will be charged a cancellation fee (equivalent to the full day's fee) if the position cannot be back filled. To avoid being charged, please call or notify us before 9am the day before your booking.

Please note that if your child is attending OSHC on an advertised excursion day, there is **no option** to remain at school. All children will be required to attend the excursion.

If your child/ren is placed on the waiting list, it is the parent's responsibility to telephone and check availability with the OSHC Director. You will be advised if your child has been approved or waitlisted for a requested booking once your booking form is received. Please do not assume that your child has been accepted onto the booking list.

An OSHC Educator will contact you to approve your booking or to advise if your child's waitlist status has changed.

If a child's enrolment form or the returned Vacation Care booking form indicates that medication is required for a child, it is the parent's responsibility to ensure that medication is handed over to OSHC Educators upon drop off on the child's first day of attendance. This includes providing OSHC with emergency medical plans (ie. Asthma, Anaphylaxis, Allergies) and written instructions on dosage. All medication will be stored in a secure location by OSHC Educators. It should be noted that OSHC Staff are not responsible for sourcing or supplying medication for any child.

The program may change to suit circumstances. All excursions are subject to last minute changes or cancellations due to weather conditions, booking issues and attendance numbers. It is a requirement that all children are signed in and out by a parent. Supervision of children is strictly limited to the hours indicated. A late fee of \$50 every 15 minutes will apply after 6:00pm.

No personal devices are brought to Vacation care.

Parents of children who become unwell will be contacted and asked to collect their child. A child in need of urgent medical attention will be taken to hospital by ambulance. Parents are responsible for all medical, ambulance or related costs incurred. Continued attempts to inform the parent or emergency contact will be undertaken until contact is made.

In the event of an accident or illness involving a child, where contact with parent/caregivers is unsuccessful despite continued attempts, the staff member in charge is authorised to consent (on behalf of the parent/caregivers) to any emergency / critical medical or surgical treatment if a registered medical practitioner considers it urgent and necessary. The doctor or medical specialist listed on a child's enrolment form may be contacted on behalf of a parent in an emergency to arrange consultation, and any necessary or relevant details may also be passed on to medical personnel.
